All sessions will be delivered online via Zoom. The German or English language courses, learning materials assignments and peer reviews will be accessible via your personal learning environment.


The EQAsce Academy organizes seven learning formats; you can choose your own order of all seven

- **3. Knowledge-to-practice sessions:** Collaborative sessions under expert guidance putting knowledge to practice
- **4. Individual and peer-reviewed reflections:** Short assignments to contribute and receive valuable feedback from others
- **5. Module assignments:** Self-paced, peer-reviewed assignments to test your acquired knowledge and apply your new skills in real-life scenarios
- **6. Seminars:** Focused, one-hour learning sessions delivered by experienced partnerships practitioners
- **7. Self-paced resources:** Course material and supporting ressources like articles, case studies, videos

## **Recognition & certification**
